Further, an objective behind Creekside offering independent study is so that our students can foster outside passions and interests. However, please be aware that Creekside Charter Management does not offer and is not affiliated with any skiing or other winter sport program. Accordingly, you are solely responsible for determining whether any particular ski or winter sport program fits your student's needs and offers services in a safe manner. You are also solely responsible for transportation to and from the sport activities and the School, this includes a parent's right to allow a student to sign themselves out of school.

If a student will be leaving our resource centers prior to the regularly scheduled departure time to receive ski lessons and training, Creekside Charter Management will need for you to complete the attached acknowledgement form and return it to me. Students who do not have the attached form on file will not be released prior to the scheduled departure time without a parent picking them up on campus.
